 COLLEGE OF SOCIAL SCIENCES FOR AUGUST-SEPTEMBER, 2026 AT YOUR INSTITUTION**

The College of Social Sciences requests your support in securing attachment for some of our second year students for **eight (8) weeks** Practical Training at your Institution. The tentative dates for the training are from **3rd August, 2026 – 25th September, 2026**. Practical Training is intended to expose students to the real-world work environment and the challenges involved, while also helping to establish and maintain close relations between the University of Dar es Salaam and industry including ministries, the private sector, public sector organizations (MDAs, LGAs), parastatals, academia, international organizations, NGOs/CBOs, hospitals etc. Specifically, Practical Training aims at enabling students to:

- Develop skills in mental health, counselling, and psychosocial support, including clinical psychology, psychiatry, and HIV/AIDS interventions.
- Work with children and families in therapy, counselling, and behavioral interventions.
- Design community mental health programmes, conduct group interventions, and support behavioral change initiatives.
- Provide counselling and promote gender equality and advocacy to gender-based violence survivors and design psychosocial support programmes.
- Conduct social behavioral research, mental health studies programme evaluation.
- Provide counseling, mental health support, and behavioral interventions for vulnerable populations.

Our students can conduct their Practical Training in a number of fields including counseling, welfare services, rehabilitation centers, health, children centers, and other social sciences related fields.

Kindly be informed that there will be no costs on your part, unless the costs are for operations linked to the activities of your institution/organization. The College will maintain contacts with your institution for the duration of the Practical Training. A supervisor from the College will visit your institution to supervise the

students for a few days during the eight weeks of Practical Training. Students are required to undergo a supervised Practical Training and expected to;

- Apply theoretical knowledge acquired in classroom to solve real life problems.
- Learn and follow the host institution's rules and adapt to the working environment.
- Acquire appropriate work experience to complement academic training.
- Fully observe and participate in PT tasks/ assignments given by the supervisor of the host institution.
- Appreciate services and guidance rendered.
- Demonstrate discipline, creativity, accountability, confidentiality, and responsible conduct, respect and zeal in learning working skills.

The College of Social Sciences and indeed the University of Dar es Salaam will highly appreciate your cooperation in accepting our students for Practical Training in your Institution. Your support is invaluable to the training and educating these young minds, and the development of human resources of our nation. Since theory and practice are the cornerstone of learning, you will have provided us with a golden opportunity to merge the two.
