

ANNOUNCEMENT FOR A SHORT COURSE ON ENVIRONMENTAL IMPACT ASSESSMENT

The Department of Geography of the University of Dar es Salaam and the National Environmental Management Council of Tanzania are conducting a short course on Environmental Impact Assessment (EIA) for those who wish to become environmental and social impact experts in different fields. The course is expected to enable those who seek to be certified as environmental and social impact experts to:

- ☞ gain both scientific knowledge on environmental issues and practical skills on how to conduct environmental impact studies in different and specialized fields;
- ☞ be able to comply with the requirements of the environmental impact assessment laws and design mitigation strategies.
- ☞ obtain specialized training for those who wish to become environmental officers, district executive directors, district environmental officers etc.

Dates: 27 – 31 May 2019 and for those with field experience and three weeks in August for those with no fieldwork experience.

Location: University of Dar es Salaam, Department of Geography, GIS room.

Costs: The costs for the training will be TZS 500,000 per week of training, and will include fees and refreshments. The August programme will contain fieldwork and assignments.

Mode of Delivery: The course will be conducted in English and will include lectures, seminars, workshops, discussions, practical fieldwork, excursion and classroom assignments base on the levels of understanding on environmental issues and impact, nature and needs of the participants.

Instructors: are from Geography Department (University of Dar es Salaam) and the National Environmental Management Council (NEMC). Other instructors will be drawn from Economics, Sociology, Law, Engineering, Marine Science, Agriculture, Geology and from companies and firms with experience in environmental impact assessment and audit nationally and internationally.

Training will include the following courses:

- ☞ Introduction to environmental impact assessment;
- ☞ Policy Legal and Institutional Framework for Environmental Assessment;
- ☞ Environmental Valuation;
- ☞ Impact Assessment Processes;
- ☞ Stakeholder Participation and Ethical issues in EIA;
- ☞ Environmental Auditing and Monitoring;
- ☞ EIA reporting;
- ☞ Environmental and Social Consultancy Services;
- ☞ Corporate Environmental and Social Assessment and Management System;
- ☞ Strategies for Environmental Assessment;
- ☞ Specialized EIA for sectors such as:

energy (oil and gas and hydro-electric power); mining; industries; business; tourism; construction; agriculture; population relocation and resettlement; landfills; impact associated with disaster, climate change, humanitarian emergencies etc.

Application letters should include academic background of applicants, the field in which they are working or want to become experts on, and should also indicate whether they would like to do fieldwork and any expectations from the programme.
