I am glad to inform you that you have been selected for admission to University of Dar es Salaam Mineral Resources Institute where you will pursue a three-year diploma course in the selected course above. Your admission is subject to accepting and fulfilling the following conditions:

1. TRAVELLING COSTS

You will be paying your traveling costs when coming to the Institute and during your vacations. For off-campus students, they will bear their day-to-day traveling costs from their residences to the Institute and back to their residences.

2. ACCOMODATION

2.1 Dodoma Campus

Accommodation services are available at MRI Dodoma Campus premises. Interested students are required to apply for the services but allocations will be based on "first come first served" arena. The application form for accommodation services is attached to this document (MRI FORM No. 6). Students are also allowed to stay off-campus, especially those who reside in Dodoma or who can easily acquire accommodation through their relatives living in Dodoma.

2.2 Nzega Campus

Accommodation services are available at MRI Nzega Campus premises for all students who have been selected to join at Nzega Campus. It should be noted that, ALL students are supposed to stay in Campus, students are strictly not allowed to stay off-campus.

3. MEAL ALLOWANCES

Meal services are available at Institute's Cafeteria at both Dodoma and Nzega Campus. However, a student will incur his/ her own cost for this service.

4. *NHIF*

Students who are not members of National Health Insurance Fund (NHIF) shall pay an annual fee of **TShs. 50,400**/= for NHIF membership. For students who are already members of NHIF will be required to verify the validity of their membership through ARIS3 during semester registration. No student will be registered if he/she is not an active member of NHIF.

5. STUDY MATERIALS

Every student will bear his/her own expenses for books, stationeries, scientific calculator, field study, clothing, footwear etc.

6. CAUTION MONEY

Each student shall be required to deposit **TShs. 10,000**/= as a collateral security that shall be used to recover lost or damaged Institute property.

7. IDENTITY CARD

Each student shall be required to pay TShs. 5,000/= per semester for the production of identity card.

8. INDUSTRIAL PRACTICAL TRAINING EXPENSES

At the end of semester II, there shall be an Industrial Practical Training (IPT) for the period of 30 to 56 days depending on the program. Students should have enough fund for transport, meals and accommodation during Industrial Practical Training.

9. STUDENT'S UNION MEMBERSHIP FEES

There is a students' union known as Dar es Salaam University Students Organization (DARUSO). Your registration as a student of this Institute entitles you to automatic membership to this student union. You will, therefore, be obliged to contribute to this organization by paying a non-refundable membership fee of **TShs. 5,000**/=. This fee is paid at the beginning of each academic year.

10. NACTE QUALITY ASSURANCE FEE

All students are required to pay an annual fee of **TShs. 20,000**/= for NACTE Quality Assurance and Quality Control.

11. SAFETY REQUIREMENTS

MRI is committed to ensuring safety of all students. Therefore, it is mandatory that all prospective students bring with them Personal Protective Equipment (PPE) as listed below.

- A pair of Safety Boots
- Helmet (Hard Hat)
- Reflector Cloth
- Reflective Coverall (Overall)
- Safety Glasses
- Raincoat



NOTE: You are supposed to declare the above-mentioned items during your registration. No registration will be granted in the absence of either of the above-mentioned requirements. You will be prohibited to attend any practical, field excursion or Industrial Practical Training unless you wear PPEs. SAFETY FIRST!!!!!

12. REPORTING DATE

Every selected student shall report to his/her scheduled campus and NOT otherwise. The reporting date is Monday 23rd October, 2023.

13. DEFERMENT OF ADMISSION

Students who have been selected but cannot join the University for any Reason cannot defer the admission to the next year. Such students need to apply afresh for the coming year.

14. PAYMENT MODE

All payments shall be done online through the University Students' Academic Registration Information System (ARIS3). Instructions on how to use this system will be given soon after students report at the Institute.

15. REGISTRATION REQUIREMENTS

All students should have the following during registration:

- (a) Original and certified copies of birth, academic certificates and transcripts. (The original will be returned after verification). Academic Certificates should include O-level (and A-level if available).
- (b) Two colored passport size photographs, (with blue background).

- (c) Original receipt of payment of Institute fees. The payable fees are attached herewith.
- (d) Admission letter for respective program (may be collected at the Institute upon arrival)
- (e) Two copies of registration forms duly filled with students' information, the names appearing on the registration forms should match the ones appearing in the O-level and A-level/diploma certificates as well as the admission letter. No additional names will be accepted.
