

Previously, as Director General of the Australian Safeguards and Non-Proliferation Office (ASNO), he led Australia's compliance with landmark treaties, including the CTBT and NPT. Dr. Floyd's leadership extends to chairing the IAEA Safeguards Implementation Advisory Group (SAGSI), co-chairing the CPPNM Preparatory Committee, and serving as Australia's Sherpa for the Nuclear Security Summit. His extensive public service includes senior advisory positions in the Australian Department of the Prime Minister and Cabinet, focusing on national security. With a Ph.D. in Population Ecology and two decades as a research scientist at CSIRO, Dr. Floyd brings a unique interdisciplinary perspective. His commitment to global security and gender equality has earned him prestigious recognitions, including Kazakhstan's Commemorative Medal and the 2021 ANA Award.
