Research Funding Opportunities with Deadlines in the First and Second Quarters of 2026

1. GACD Implementation Science Call on Non-Communicable Diseases (HORIZON-HLTH-2026-01-DISEASE-09)

Deadline 16 April 2026

Focus Implementation research addressing non-communicable diseases through multisectoral interventions in LMIC settings.

Indicative Grant Size: \$3.2M to fund 4-5 projects

Eligibility International research teams working on implementation science related to NCD prevention or management in LMICs.

Prep: Submit coordinated consortium proposal through participating funding agencies following GACD application guidance.

2. AO Trauma Clinical Priority Program (CPP) - Large Research Grants

Deadline: 30 March 2026

Focus: Multicenter trauma research studies

Indicative Grant Size: Up to CFH 150k (\$193k) per year for maximum five years

Eligibility: Global applicants, LMIC priority

Prep: Submit detailed multicenter proposal

3. Oscar & Lili Lamm Foundation Research Grants

Deadline: 3 June 2026

Focus: Scientific research on landscape conservation and plant protection

Indicative Grant Size: Up to SEK 1m (\$105k)

Eligibility: PhD holders affiliated with Swedish universities/colleges, or an approved organization recognized by the foundation

Prep: Submit research proposal and supporting documentation through the foundation's grant application system

4. TWAS - Seed Grant for New African Principal Investigators (SG-NAPI)

Deadline: 31 March 2026

Focus: High-level research projects in Agriculture, Science and Engineering

Indicative Grant Size: Up to USD 67,700 (30-month duration; equipment, consumables, literature, partial fieldwork, MSc student support, conference grants, industrial link grants, mobility grants, open access publication support, and scientist-after-child component for female researchers)

Eligibility: Early-career PhD holders (≤ 40 years) with good research experience

Prep: Submit online application via TWAS portal; upload proforma invoices for equipment \geq USD 5k, PhD certificate, CV, research proposal, institutional support letter, and references. Agreement signed between TWAS, PI, and home institution

5. AO Trauma Clinical Priority Program (CPP) - Small Research Grants

Deadline: 30 March 2026

Focus: Clinical trauma research projects

Indicative Grant Size: Up to CFH 50k (\$64k) for a maximum of one year

Eligibility: Clinicians and scientists globally

Prep: Submit proposal via AO Foundation portal
