#### 1 FEES AND BURSARIES

## **1.1 Regular Undergraduate Degree Programmes**

Candidates selected to pursue the various degree programmes offered by the University of Dar es Salaam are required to pay tuition and other University fees by the beginning of the first semester before they can be permitted to use the University facilities. The fees once paid are not refundable. Also, the University reserves the right to revise fees as may be appropriate. The tuition fees for the various programmes for Tanzanian and Non-Tanzanian students are indicated in Table 1:
