



Call for applications for Masters scholarships at Zhejiang Ocean University in China

The University of Dar es Salaam School of Aquatic Sciences and Fisheries Technology (SoAF) in collaboration with Zhejiang Ocean University in China is announcing scholarships in three MSc programmes, namely Marine Biology, Aquaculture, and Food Processing and Safety. The students will receive a partial scholarship to pursue one of these three programmes. Therefore, students interested in any of the aforementioned MSc programmes are encouraged to apply.

Scholarship coverage

This is a partial scholarship that will be granted for up to three years to cover tuition, research, accommodation, and a monthly stipend of 500 RMB (only while in China).

Note: Due to the COVID-19 pandemic, there is no guarantee that the selected students will be able to go and study offline in China from September 2022. Students who have the necessary online learning facilities, such as laptop, stable internet connection, quiet learning environment and others are encouraged to apply.

- Two recommendation letters.
