Why the 1st Annual Agricultural Conference and Exhibition in Kagera?

Kagera region is known for its potential on: i) peculiar agricultural systems, ii) commercial and food crops, iii) contribution to food security in the country, iv) supportive agricultural climatic condition, v) inputs responsive agricultural soil, vi) endowed water bodies occupying more than 29% of the total land mass vii) inherently market place positioning across its borders, vii) agricultural forest, viii) livestock fattening and beekeeping, ix) blue economy x) agro processing and manufacturing of packaging materials, and xi) utilizing agricultural experts across the country. Regardless of all these potentials, Kagera's per capita gross domestic product is the 26th across the Tanzania mainland, and its habitats – predominantly peasant have remained economically weak. The region's low resilience and recovery mechanisms against natural calamities, and inaccessibility of research-based knowledge are amongst the factors leads to the region's economic weakness. It without doubt that if the former and the latter are well addressed they could help in maximizing productivity through addressing the vices that harness agriculture endeavours in the region and take advantage of Kagera's geographical location in agribusiness. The accessibility of the proven researched knowledge, however, has to be injected for a reasonable time to live an impactful and meaningful mark in the livelihood of the Kagera's people and nation at large. It is against the above background that we propose and plan to organise agricultural conference and exhibitions to be held in the region on annual basis.

The conference will bring together academicians, researchers, agricultural experts, granting agencies, banks; mobile companies, government authorities, farmers, and any other related stakeholders along the agriculture-value chain who will express their interests to participate.
