Introduction

The Sasamani Foundation, in partnership with the University of Dar es Salaam Business School presents Women Leading Change program. This innovative and transformative leadership program for women unlocks your individual leadership skills and increases your confidence to lead positive change. Women Leading Change gathers experienced educators from the University of Dar es Salaam (Tanzania) and the Amani Institute (Kenya) to deliver a world-class and culturally relevant program. The unique approach delivers five days of classroom learning combined with customized one-on-one coaching and ongoing peer networks to support you as you apply lessons in real-world environments.

Participants will receive classroom instruction from 22nd to 26th of August 2022 at the University of Dar es Salaam Business School, followed by four months of real-world application with the support of a leadership coach.



Target Audience

Mid-career East African women from business, government, and non-profit sectors. Participants should be 25 years and above, college graduates, and fluent in English.

Certification

Participants earn a UDSM Business School Certificate of participation and completion after finishing four months of coaching.

Training Fees

The program cost is US\$3,000 per participant. While our generous donors cover most of these costs, each participant is responsible to contribute 580,500 TZS or US\$250.

Deadline For Submission

The deadline for application submission is the 30th of June 2022.
