















Call for Applications for MSc Scholarship

The Norwegian University of Life Sciences and the Universities of Dar es Salaam (UDSM), Lilongwe University of Aquaculture and Natural Resources (LUANAR), University of Edwardo Mondlane (UEM), Mbeya University of Science and Technology (MUST), Egerton University (EU), University of Zambia (UNZA), Makerere University (MU) and University of Nairobi (UoN) are implementing a project titled "Enhanced Capacity for Aquatic Resources in East and South Africa (ECARESA)". This is a 6-year project that is being implemented with financial support from the Royal Kingdom of Norway under NORAD's NORHED II Program. Research activities under this project are focusing on aquaculture, aquatic health, ecotoxicology, diseases and Anti-Microbial Resistance (AMR). The project has therefore budgeted funds to support MSc level studies in Aquatic Animal Health and Ecosystem Management by course work and dissertation at LUANAR. After successful completion of the course work the research for the dissertation will be conducted in Tanzania.

MSc Study at LUANAR

One (1) full MSc fellowship is available for a student from Tanzania to be registered for study at LUANAR in **Aquatic Animal Health and Ecosystem Management**. The scholarship covers tuition fees, basic living and research expenses. The applicants should ideally have a Bachelor of Science Degree in areas such as Aquaculture, Fisheries Science, Animal/Veterinary Science or other relevant biological sciences, with at least a Credit pass. Female applicants are strongly encouraged to apply.
