A candidate shall be deemed eligible for consideration for admission into the Certificate in Law Programme of the University of Dar es Salaam if the candidate has obtained Certificate of Secondary Education Examination (C.S.E.E) and has scored a minimum of D grade in four subjects or equivalent **or** passed the Advanced Certificate of Secondary Education Examination (A.C.S.E.E.). Candidates who do not have the required qualifications may be admitted in exceptional circumstances on the recommendations of the Board of the University of Dar es Salaam School of Law.

The duration of study shall be for a maximum period of two semesters of full time attendance.
