Bidding will be conducted through the National Competitive Bidding procedures as specified in the World Bank's *Guidelines: Procurement of Goods, Works and Non-Consulting Services under IBRD Loans and IDA Credits & Grants by World Bank Borrowers* **Fourth Edition of November 2020** ("Procurement Guidelines"), and is open to all eligible bidders as defined in the Procurement Guidelines.
