The University of Dar es Salaam now invites sealed bids from eligible bidders for Supply, Installation, Testing, Training And Commissioning Of ICT Infrastructure And Services; And Install New ICT Data Communication Networks, Including Core, LAN, And WLAN (Wi-Fi) At University Of Dar-Es-Salaam Mwalimu Julius Kambarage Nyerere Mlimani Campus the quantities are as per the schedule of requirement attached in this bidding document, the equipment are to be installed at the University of Dar es Salaam Mwl. J. K. Nyerere Mlimani Campus, the equipment are expected to be delivered within Four (4) months from the date of contract signing.

Bidding will be conducted through the National Competitive Bidding procedures as specified in the World Bank's <u>Guidelines: Procurement of Goods, Works and Non-Consulting Services under</u> <u>IBRD Loans and IDA Credits & Grants by World Bank Borrowers</u> Fourth Edition of November **2020** ("Procurement Guidelines"), and is open to all eligible bidders as defined in the Procurement Guidelines. In addition, please refer to paragraphs 1.6 and 1.7 setting forth the World Bank's policy on conflict of interest.

6. Bids must be submitted online through TANePS - <u>https://www.taneps.go.tz</u> in on or before 1100hrs on 9th February, 2023 and bids will be opened through TANePS on 9th February, 2023 at 1130 hours. The TANePS would not allow any late submission of bids.
