Erasmus+ International Credit Mobility programme enables to exchange faculty members between PARTNER UNIVERSITY and Marmara University for teaching mobility activities. This call includes Erasmus+ International Credit Mobility Project, contract no: 2022-1-TR01-KA171-HED-000077090.

Teaching mobility – STA

The objective of the mobility is to encourage higher education institutions to broaden and enrich the range and content of courses they offer.

WHO CAN PARTICIPATE?

- Full-time academic staff employed at the home university can apply for staff mobility.
- Applicants are expected to have knowledge of sufficient foreign language to carry out the activity.

DURATION OF MOBILITY

Mobilities will take place in 5 business days (excluding travel days) per staff.

The mobilities must be completed by 30/09/2024.

A teaching activity has to comprise a minimum of **8 hours** of teaching per week.

APPLICATION PROCESS AND TIMINGS

THIS SECTION WILL BE DETERMINED BY THE INSTITUTION

SELECTION

At the selection stage, the following selection criteria will be taken into account. In the case of an equivalency, the preference will go to those who have been selected/invited by the host institution.

- 1. Job experience at University of Dar es Salaam
 - *a.* < 1 year: **0 point**
 - b. 1-2 years: 1 point
 - c. 2-3 years: + 3 points
 - *d.* 3-5 years: + 5 points
 - *e.* 5-7 years: + 7 points
 - *f.* > 7 years: + 9 points
- 2. Erasmus College/Department Coordinators at the time of application: + 6 points

- 3. For each previous participation in the Erasmus+ Staff Mobility within KA107 (Erasmus+ Staff Exchange between Program and Partner Countries): 5 points
- 4. Participation in Erasmus programme in the country of nationality: 10 points
- 5. Academic/Administrative staff who have directly contributed to the University of Dar es Salaam's Erasmus+ exchange activities by finding new international partners from European countries: max.+ 20 points (for each agreement: + 5 points)
- 6. Contribution to KA107 project writing process and/or relevance of the project: $\mathbf{0} \mathbf{30}$ points
- 7. Disadvantaged staff (The statement from a doctor or other relevant authority confirming the special needs should be submitted to the International Office during the application period): +10 points
- 8. Meeting the language criteria shared below: +10 points
 - a. TOEFL IBT (internet-based): 80
 - b. TOEFL pBT (paper-based): 550
 - c. ELTS: 70
 - d. A degree certificate showing that education in the designated programme's language was received by the applicant
- **9.** Required academic field: Engineering, manufacturing, Textiles (clothes, footwear and leather), Nanotechnology, Biomaterial and Biochemistry +10 points

FUNDING

1. Individual Support for Participants

Every participant will receive a mobility grant composed of subsistence support according to the length of stay (in days).

• Outgoing staff: EUR 140/day

2. Travel Support for Participants

Each selected individual participant will receive a travel contribution. Travel grant will be paid along with the individual grant upon arrival at Marmara University.
