- A citizen of Tanzania, aged 35 or below
- A staff of the University of Dar es Salaam, with a Bachelor GPA of 3.8 or above
- Admitted in the Masters Program in the areas of Agriculture, Business, Agribusiness or related program at the University of Dar es Salaam (UDSM)
